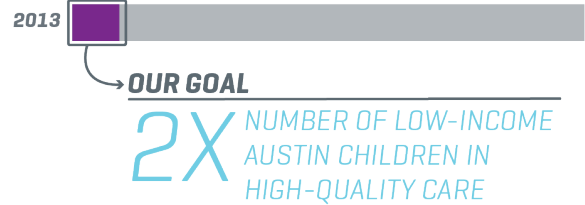


Success By 6 Center Project

UWATX is working with **12 child care centers serving low-income children** all over Austin to help them meet and keep high-quality standards by providing an array of supportive services. These centers serve **700 to 1,000 children**.

Child Care Centers Fast Facts

- › Approximately 60 percent of all the children served are from low-income families.
- › Approximately 15 percent of all the children served primarily speak Spanish.
- › Center size ranges from 30 to 150 children.
- › Approximately 180 teachers are employed in the centers we're working with.



What UWATX is providing:



Parent education: Helping parents get the skills they need to support their child's development.



Social emotional learning: Funding licensed professionals to provide on-site mentoring and counseling for children, teachers and other educators.



High-quality resources: Leveraging in-kind support to provide resources, (including a math curriculum that helps prepare children for STEM education) technology support and more.



Teacher development: Support for continuing education and professional development.



Director mentoring: Funding a mentorship program for directors to grow their management and leadership skills through research-based practices.



Data analysis and coordination: Collecting data through regular classroom observations and children's assessments and then utilizing state-of-the-art technology provided by IBM to review data, determine needs and coordinate efforts.
